Most of the presented papers had been published on 126 pages of the 42nd volume of the Colloquium Biometricum, the official periodical of the Polish Biometric Society. One conference attraction was a trip to the house in Zelazowa Wola, where Fryderyk Chopin was born. Moreover, we had an opportunity to visit the organizers' impressive experimental fields. During the entire meeting we were served all sorts of fruits, including apples, pears, strawberries, and blueberries. The atmosphere of the conference was very friendly.

The StatSoft of Poland has founded a prize for the best presentation by a young biometrician. The 2012 winner was Adriana Derejko (Warsaw University of Life Sciences).
