As announced before, the XVIIIth International Biometric Conference will be held 1-5th July 1996 in Amsterdam, the Netherlands. The ANed, the Dutch region of the Biometric Society is pleased to organize the conference which will be hosted at the Vrije Universiteit of Amsterdam. The Local Organizing Committee and all its subcommittees, which started the preparations more than two years ago, are increasingly busy, but all preparations are still on schedule. The scientific program will be of high level and interesting for a large audience. During the week there will be ample opportunity to make new scientific contacts, to meet old friends or to make new ones. In the August issue of the Biometric Bulletin the official Second Announcement will appear, with registration forms, abstract forms and detailed information about hotel accommodation. ### Social Program

There will be a reception, offered by the Mayor of Amsterdam, on Monday evening, July 1. This will take place in the Stedelijk Museum of Amsterdam.

On Wednesday July 3 we will have the traditional day off to make a tour and to relax. There will be four organized tours :

- The Zuiderzee Museum in Enkhuizen (open air museum) and the famous Zaanse Schans. A tour to two of the finest, historical sights in The Netherlands.

- The Kroller Muller Museum (world famous collection of fine art) and the Apenheul (forest park with all kind of free-living monkeys)

- Guided walking tour through the center of Amsterdam and a boat trip on the river Vecht with its famous old manors.

- Nature walk through sand hills and over beaches along the coast of the North Sea.

On Thursday July 4, the conference dinner will take place in Volendam, a characteristic Dutch fishing village near Amsterdam. After a walk through this beautiful village with its picturesque small houses, canals and drawbridges, dinner will be served by a staff dressed in the traditional, local costumes.
